



# CONCLUSION PEST CONTROL

## PREPARATION FOR BED BUG TREATMENT

***A complete bed bug treatment is considered 2 full treatments 10 -14 days apart. It is important you remain out of the unit for approximately 4-6 hours following the treatments. If you have any respiratory or other medical issues it is recommended that you stay out of the unit for 24 hours.***

**Bedroom Preparation** Remove all items away from the walls. Vacuum all floor areas including around all baseboards and all furniture. Wash and dry all bedding including comforters, sheets, pillows, bed skirts, etc. Remove all items from the dressers and night stands. Launder all clothing items and place in a sealed bag. Remove all items from closets and place in sealed bag. All mattresses and box springs must be placed upright against the wall. All furniture should be moved at least 12 inches away from the walls. Place all treated sealed bags in an area that does not require treatment.

**Living Room Preparation** Remove all items away from the walls. Vacuum all floor areas including around all baseboards and all furniture. All furniture should be moved at least 12 inches away from the walls. Place sofa on its side so technician can have access to the under area of the sofa.

**General Preparation Information** Remove footwear from entrances All electrical wall plates should be removed. All paintings, mirrors, and wall accessories should be removed from living room and walls. Gather all drapes, blinds, etc, and either tie back or fully open. Remove all electronics away from walls Remove all items from under kitchen and bathroom sinks. Empty storage rooms completely.

**After Treatment Information** Following the treatment, do not wash within 6 inches of the baseboard area for approximately 3 weeks.
